The stage is set: it is off to Singapore on March 12 and then to Cambodia on March 14. The trip will start with Dr. Lynelle Kerr who does the special kind of chiropractice called NSA (Neural Spinal Analysis) which seems to be greatly helping the rescued child sex workers in a home near Phnom Penh. It is there that we are employing an English teacher for a year to start the girls off on a path to some sort of useful professional training.

I am looking forward to meeting the 80 girls there and also visiting other homes. It seems important to get a feel for what is going on there and to see what else can be done. We seem to have fallen into this particular area after giving a donation to the organization in Thailand a few years back. They did training programs for women who had left prostitution.

Another aspect of this trip consists in becoming acquainted with the projects being undertaken by a friend of my brother's. At present he is on the track of looking at a revolutionary way of providing clean water to as many places as possible in Cambodia.
