Moanoghar School Class room Building 2014-2015

Moanoghar is situated in the Chittagong Hill Tracts. It is a school with the mission to offer education to children from indigenous families. Over 800 students board at Moanoghar with a further 500 coming in for daily lessons. Lack of classrooms leads to over-crowding: sometimes well over 100 pupils in a classroom!!!

Lack of classrooms and accommodation necessitates the turning away of hundreds of children every year. And so decided to reduce the classroom size by building new classrooms. So here you have a perspective of where we are at today, October 11, 2015, about 2 months before the great opening on December 4-6, 2015. Amazing to see something come up out of nothing!
