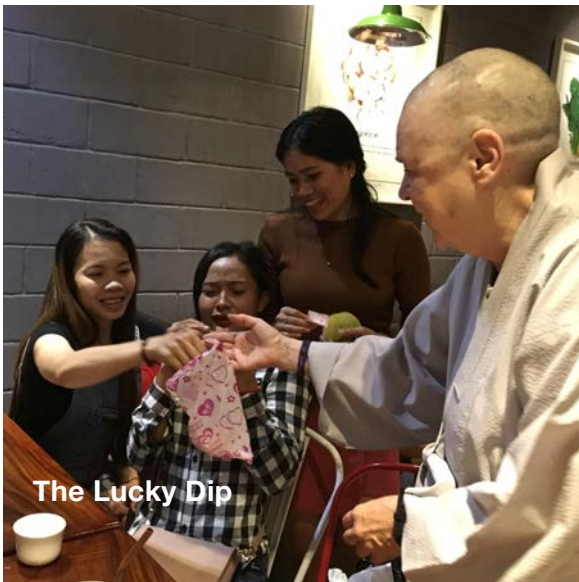


Annual PN Dinner 2018
